1. Principal's report

Luana asked to open the roll for years 1,2,4,5 outside of zone for 2024. The Board approved.

Luana and Bret have been meeting regularly on the property project. The schedule is running later than planned. Luana is working on how to accommodate the lack of class spaces for Term 4. Her plan is to merge the three senior classes into two classes and create a break room with the extra teacher. In the interest of class continuity Luana plans to keep the senior classes in the same place for the entire term rather than reshuffle them again.
