Strategic Plan - Draft Goals

Last term, the Board of Trustees started community consultation for the Strategic Plan for 2024-2026. We really want to hear your thoughts and feedback.

Draft Strategic Goals for community feedback:

- 1. Deepen our culturally responsive practice of Te āo Māori by strengthening our use and understanding of tikanga Māori, te reo Māori, the whenua, and whanaungatanga.
- 2. Either:
 - 1. Integrate our natural environment into our learning. Or:
 - 2. Inspire our akonga with an exciting local curriculum that is grounded in our natural environment.
- 3. Deliver a robust, relevant, inspiring local curriculum, in a caring and inclusive environment, providing every student with the opportunity to thrive.
- 4. Nurture connection and communication to encourage akonga, kaiako and whanau to participate together in learning and celebrate success.

Next steps:

1. Community consultation on draft strategic goals We welcome thoughts and ideas about whether these draft strategic goals are heading in the right direction and how they could be improved or better worded.

- 4. Save the images you would like to purchase to your 'Favourites'
- 5. Groups code: Save the relevant class groups to your 'Favourites'
- 6. We recommend adding your images to the shopping cart from your 'Favourites' page the images should be easier to navigate between from there.


