#### **School Structure for 2024**



#### **Class Placements**

As we have in previous years, we work with our children to ensure that everyone has an input into sharing peers they work well with and have positive relationships with so that everyone has a buddy in their class for the following year. Research tells us this is the most important factor in making classroom placements.

We will be running two transition sessions at the end of the year, as we have done previously, so students know who their class teacher is, which room they are in and which peers will be in that space with them. These sessions will happen in Week 9 and 10 of this term.

We would like to also offer whānau the chance to pop in and meet their child's class teacher for 2023. On Thursday 7th December, teachers will be in their new learning spaces from 3-3:30 so whānau have the opportunity to come and say hello as well. Please come in and introduce yourself, we'd love to connect with you!

We know that change can be challenging for some children, so we appreciate you supporting us to make these transitions to 2024 go as smoothly as possible.
